SENY offers online forums for discussion of AA-related topics under the name, "the SENY Bulletin Board." Here, interested AA members may share experience, strength and hope on topics of interest, curiosity or concern in support of AA's Three Legacies: Recovery, Unity and Service. The forums are organized by service committee (such as Public Information [PI] or Archives), service title (such as GSR or DCM) or by topic (such as beginners questions or self-support).

The forums follow essentially a Q&A format where one member posts a question or comment and another responds ultimately building up a fellowship-wide dialogue. Anyone is welcome to look over the questions and comments without registering with us in some sections, but you must register in order to view all sections and either post a question or to respond to a posted question or comment.

Registration is simple:

- From "the SENY Ask It Basket" Forum Index page, follow the link to the first page for registration. Review and agree to the "Registration Agreement Terms." Basically, you are being asked to respect all who might use these forums by avoiding inappropriate postings, and to understand that SENY will monitor and control all access and content.

- Accepting the "terms," you will be taken to the "Registration Information" page. Provide us with a username (remember, we need to maintain personal anonymity at this level, so please do not use your own actual name) and your e-mail address. (For greater personal anonymity, some may want to set up an address that reflects no personal information. Your current e-mail provider probably offers multiple addresses with your account, or you may register with one of the free services to pick another address.) Pick and confirm a password, then enter the "Confirmation code" from the shaded band near the middle of the block, and "Submit." You will be asked your username and password each time you log on to the forum.

You will not be registered until we confirm your registration via e-mail, but this is all you need to do to register.

Once you have successfully registered and received an e-mail confirming this you are set to go. The first time you log in, you may wish to check out the "Profile" page. Here you can fill out as much or as little of the information that you care to share, change your e-mail address, select an "avatar" to be your representation on the board or select another language for the board to use. Otherwise, head straight to the forum of your choice and begin to share.
